



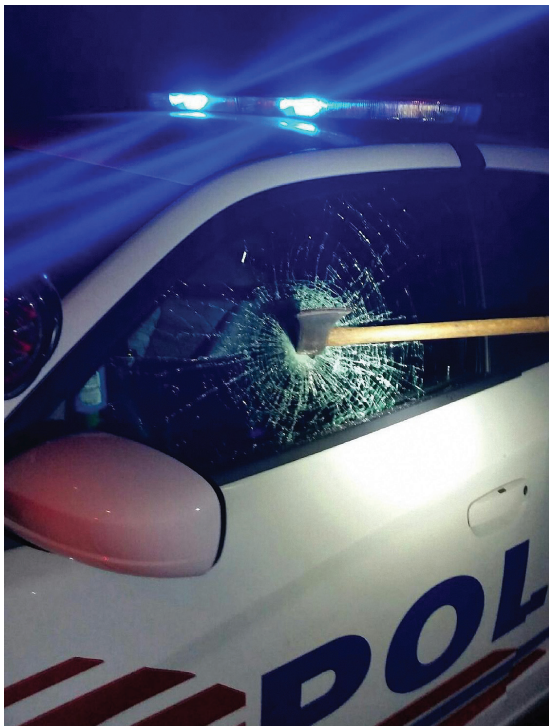
THE ANTI-AMERICANS

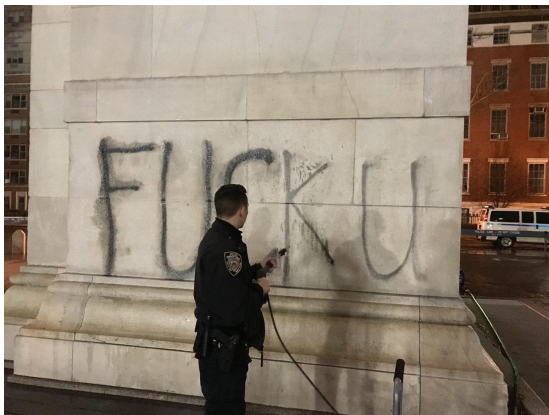






































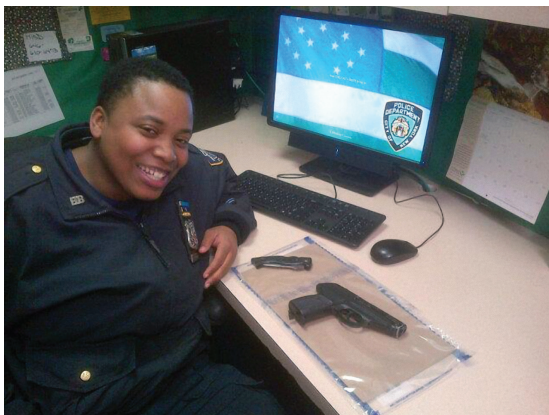

In late August, a crowd of thousands — primarily liberals and liberals — cascaded down Martin Luther King Jr. Way in Berkeley, Calif.
